DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: APRIL 21, 2008

You will be advised of receipt of the application and will be notified of your acceptance to the Course by MAY 15, 2008.

FEES: Tuition for the 7-day COURSE is **\$700** to be paid by all participants on being informed of their acceptance unless they have been granted a waiver or a partial waiver of tuition. Students traveling from the U.S. and Canada are eligible for a partial waiver if they do not have institutional support, and thus need to pay only \$250 on being informed of acceptance. Students traveling from other countries are eligible for a total waiver of tuition fees if they do not have institutional support. Tuition funding covers overhead costs of the workshop.

PAYMENT OF TUITION: Deadline for payment is **June 15**. Checks should be made out to **American Entomological Institute** and mailed to: Dr. David Wahl; American Entomological Institute; 3005 SW 56th Ave.; Gainesville, FL 32608-5047; USA

All students, whether or not they have received tuition waivers, must pay boarding fees of \$280 covering dormitory room and board, payable to American Entomological Institute prior to the course (See course description).

Transportation costs between home and Punta Cana (air) or the Biodiversity Center (auto) are to be borne by all participants or their home institutions. The course will provide transportation between the Punta Cana Airport and the Biodiversity Center.
